



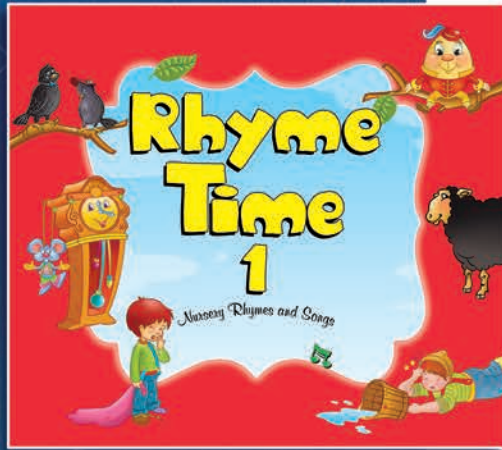

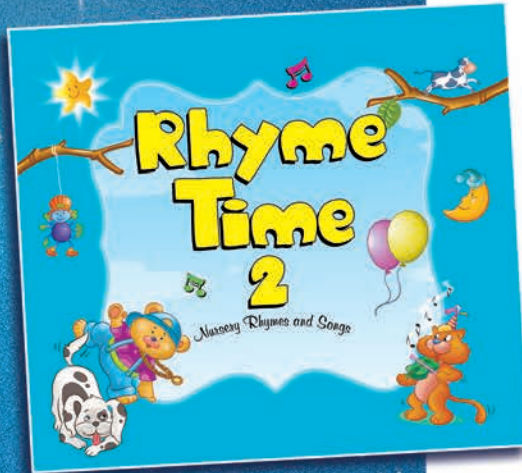

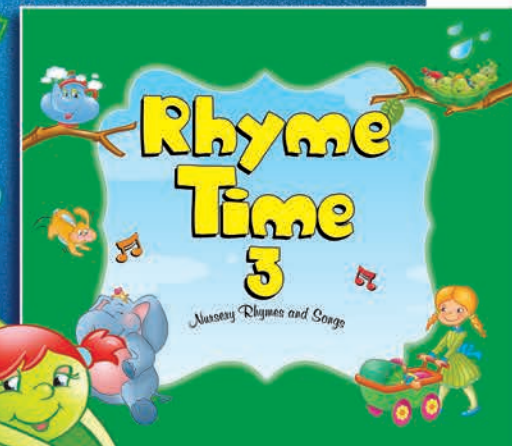

His head goes RATTLE – RATTLE – RATTLE!



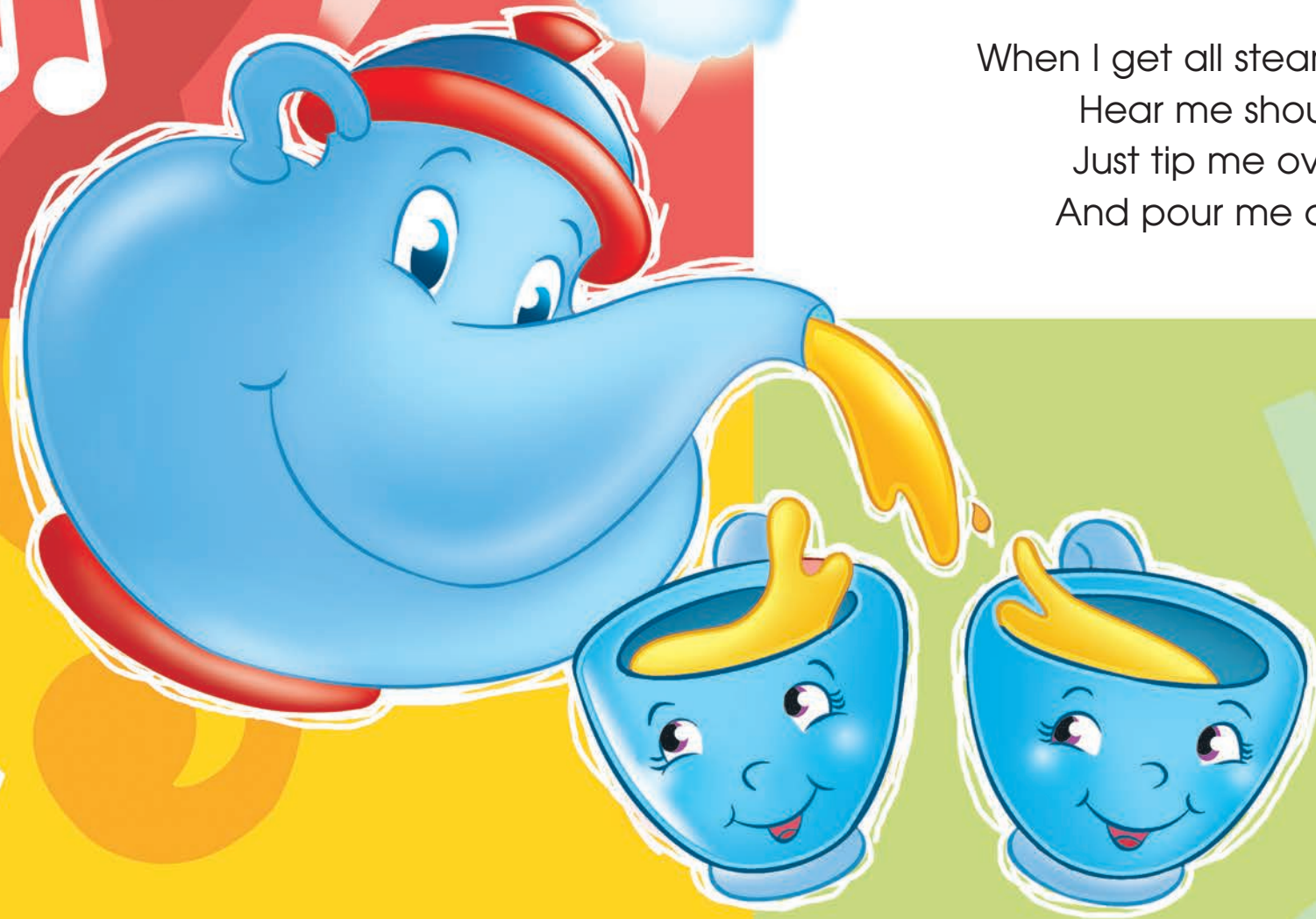
“Whoopee! Watch me steam up!” shouts Mr. Teapot.

“Time for tea!” they all shout.

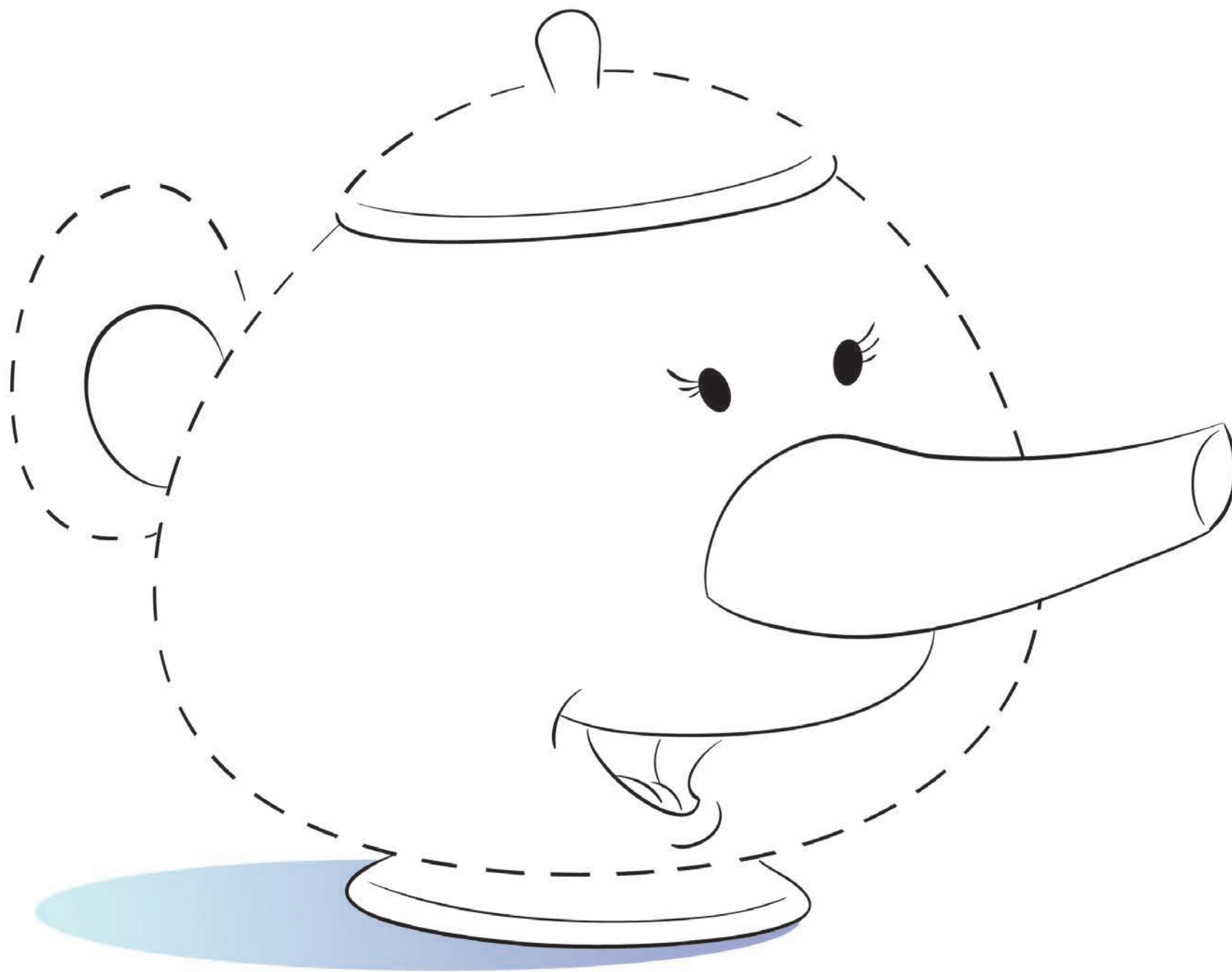


🎵 Let's sing! 🎵
