

## Pupil's Cards Intro for Parent's corner in The Flibets Microsite:

These **Pupil's Cards** depict all the key vocabulary of the course book and can be used for card games with your child. Card games are a fun way to revise vocabulary and a wonderful opportunity to teach your child about winning and losing.

Make sure you have printed at least two sets of cards so that you have two decks for every game. If you wish, your child can colour them and you can also laminate or glue them onto card to make them last longer. Should a card depict a specific colour, ask your child to locate said coloured pencil and use that one to colour the card.

It is best you start playing using only the cards of the words your child has learnt so far. You can add more cards as your child progresses in the course. One of the games which you can play with these cards is:

- ***Snap!*** This game can be played in pairs or the whole family. The goal of the game is to win all the cards you are playing with. Shuffle the cards and deal them all out between all the players. Each player puts his/her cards face-down in front of them. Indicate who will start first. The first player turns over the card at the top of his/her pile and starts a pile in the centre. The next player turns over his/her card and adds it to the pile. The game continues until two cards match. The first player to say: ***Snap!*** and name the object on the card, wins the cards in the middle. The winner is the player with all or most of the cards.
