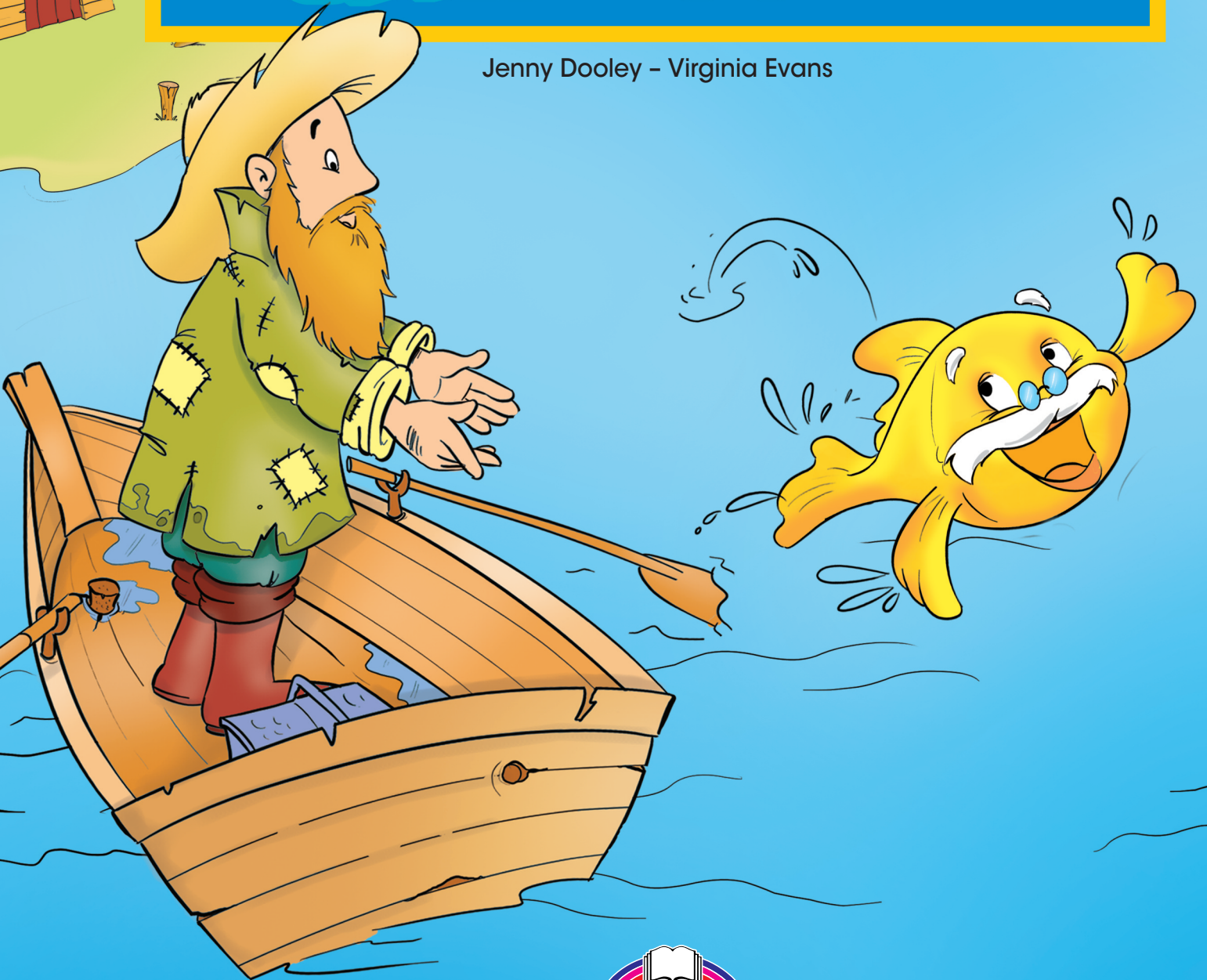

This is a story from long ago. It is about a kind old fisherman. He lives with his wife in a very small house. The fisherman works hard, but he is very poor.

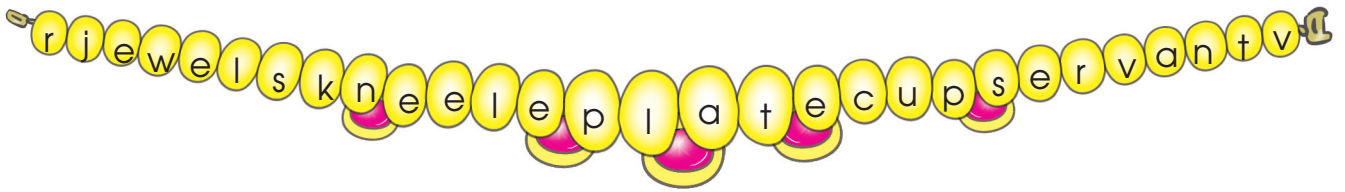


One day the fisherman catches a small golden fish.

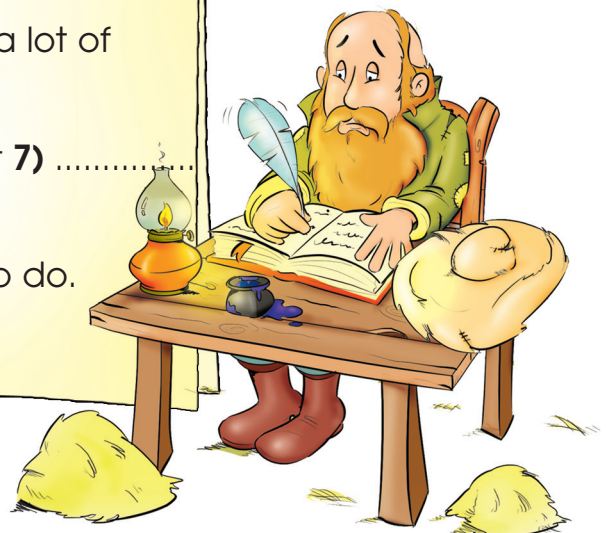
