







Children go toschool..... to learn, and they have lessons in classrooms with a **(1)**

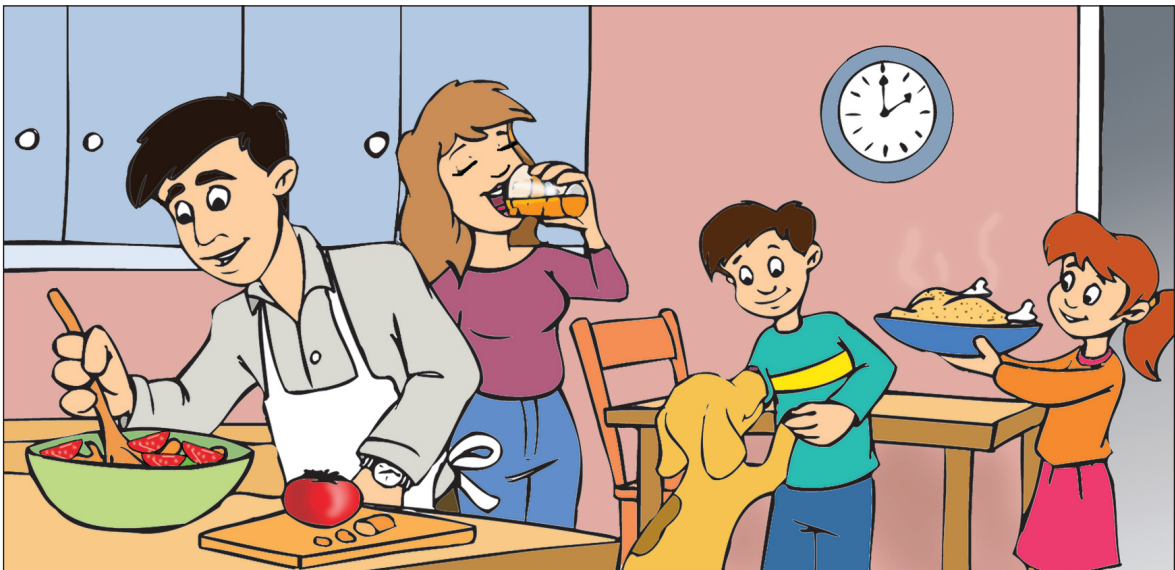
