Answers for Questions, pages 8-9

- POST: Porcupines attack other animals and people. Porcupines climb trees and usually live there. They only eat plants and the bark from trees. Hedgehogs are friendly. When they are scared, they roll up into a ball to defend themselves, but they won't attack you. They eat insects. Hedgehogs are smaller than porcupines.

- PRE: Herbert is crying because he hurt his hand. He is showing his hand to his father.
- POST: Herbert was in pain. He is scared and upset.

Answers for Questions, pages 12-13

- PRE: There was a spike in his hand. His father is using tweezers to pull the spike out.
- POST: Herbert promised he would never touch another forest animal again.
